1. Minutes and Action Items Review

- The Selection Committee tried to include pacific fellow but the submissions did not score high enough and one of them did not meet the eligibility i.e. not a current student.
- Secretariat added that the final result will be released only after the confirmed final budget from the Finance department of the local host.

Fellowship Committee Updates

- ISOC Online course already set up and the 50 fellows will start the online course from 1 June for 5 weeks on the below topics:
 - Introduction to Internet Governance
 - Internet Actors and Stakeholder Groupings
 - Internet Policy Principles
 - Internet infrastructure, standards, protocols, and systems
- The online course is a self-paced learning moderated by Mr. Fouad Bajwa and Mr. Zakir Syed which fellows are divided into 2 groups.
- Secretariat mentioned that there are enquiries from fellows whether the ISOC online course is compulsory. Secretariat and Soong suggested to encourage them to take the course as it is a valuable resource and opportunity while not indicating as mandatory due to the late inclusion of the course into the fellowship program.
- Another fellowship call will be held for deciding the details of the preconference webinar among buddies and fellows.
- Secretariat mentioned that Chat Garcia Ramilo raised a question on whether non-MSG members can be buddies of the fellows. MSG agreed the idea of opening up buddies outside of the MSG.
